Celebrate the Yuletide season on Saturday afternoon, December 16, 2023 at 2:30 pm, as The Bronx Concert Singers (BCS), guest professional vocalists and chamber orchestra, under the baton of Music Director Robert René Galván, will perform our 42nd Annual Holiday Concert at St. Helena's RC Church, 1315 Olmstead Ave., in Parkchester, Bronx, NY 10462.

Savor the warmth, tenderness, and joy of this holiday season with traditional carols, spirituals, and selections from Mendelssohn's beloved oratorio "**ELIJAH**". Vivaldi's setting of [Psalm 69] *Deus in adjutorium Domine* is an urgent prayer for divine help. Villa Lobos's *Praesepe* (Manger) contemplates the wonder of Christ's birth in a stable. Christina Rosetti poems are texts for Maurice Besly's *The Shepherds had an Angel* and 21st C composer Ola Gjeilo's *The Rose. Hanerot Halalu* celebrates the solemn triumph of Chanukah.

Orchestral works include R. Vaughan William's Welch pastoral *Rhosymedre* and J.S. Bach's *Concerto for Violin & Oboe, II BWV 1060*.
