Celebrate Life and Spring with Bronx Concert Singers' 2022 SPRING CONCERT – 'Pieces of the World'! Be captivated by songs from across the globe!

Join The Bronx Concert Singers (BCS) and Music Director Robert René Galván on <u>Saturday, May 14, 2022 at 2:30 pm</u>, for our **41st Annual Spring Concert**, performed with guest professional soloists and instrumental ensemble, in St. Helena's RC Church sanctuary, 1315 Olmstead Avenue, Parkchester, Bronx, NY 10462.

Percussion instruments accompany South Africa's familiar *Siyahamba*; Kenyan (Luo) *Hombe* thrums with a hunting hyena, and French/Swahili *Amani* demands we "sing strongly for peace for the world." Yiddish folksong *Tumbalalaika* celebrates courting, while Hebrew *Ose Shalom* contemplates The One Who Makes Peace. Jamaica's Harry Belafonte invites us to "*Turn the World Around*."

Celtic harp warms the duet *My Gentle Harp*, and solos in the Welsh "*Dafyyd y Garren Wen*". African-American Spirituals *Deep River* and *I've Been in the Storm So Long* recall the pain of losses now and over 400 years. Chilean Violetta Parra's "*Gracias a la Vida*" joyfully bursts with Thanksgiving for all her life experiences. Ariel Ramirez's *Gloria* from "*Missa Criolla*" celebrates the LORD's greatness.

Most notable is "A Ukrainian Prayer," John Rutter's 2022 tribute to Ukrainians. Composer Brian Muni's "Pieces of the World" caps the concert: he is expected to perform with us.
